September 19–29, 2027 Itinerary & Additional Information




We have enough people interested in this trip that we are working with European Educational Travel based in Basel, Switzerland and are able to provide further information, including an itinerary. This trip is open to SAHS members and non-members, and if we have to cap numbers it will be based on a first come, first served basis. **The first deposit of \$500 per person will be due on February 15, 2026,** and can be done through PayPal, or by mailing a check as you do for your annual membership dues. ITINERARY

- 3 nights in Zurich, 2 nights in Locarno, 3 nights in Lausanne and 2 nights in Bern
- Day trips/stops: Appenzell, Glarus, Luzern/Lucerne, Zermatt, Geneva and Zweisimmen



Sunday, September 19

- All arrive in Zurich pick up at airport
- Note that museums in Zurich are closed on Mondays, so you may want to visit some today if you are arriving in the morning
- Free time (for those arriving in the morning looking to relax and unwind, consider taking the train to nearby Baden from Zurich, and going to the FortySeven Wellness Spa & Thermal Baths, which is open from 8:00 AM 10:00 PM daily)



Monday, September 20

- Morning Lecture on an overview of the history of Switzerland and the city of Zurich
- Walking tour of Zurich
- Afternoon Boat Ride on Lake Zurich and/or visit to the Lindt Chocolate Factory in Kilchberg (note that museums are closed on Mondays in Zurich)



Tuesday, September 21

- Morning Train from Zurich to Appenzell
- Walking tour of Appenzell
- Train from Appenzell to Glarus
- Walking tour of Glarus with discussion of connections to New Glarus, Wisconsin
- Visit to the Reisebüro Linth (Museum of Emigration and Immigration) in Kaltbrunn
- Train back to Zurich



Wednesday, September 22

- Morning Depart Zurich
- Train from Zurich to Lucerne/Luzern
- Walking tour of Lucerne
- Boat ride
- Cog wheel train to Mount Rigi
- Train to Locarno
- Evening Check into hotel in Locarno





Thursday, September 23

- Morning Walking tour of Locarno
- Rest of the day is free time (options include a boat ride on Lake Maggiore, taking the train to Lugano or Bellinzona, visiting the Brissago Islands or Cimetta Mountain)



Friday, September 24

- Morning Depart Locarno
- Train to Zermatt
- Cog wheel train to Gornergrat
- Train to Lausanne and hotel check-in



Saturday, September 25

- Walking tour of Geneva
- Visit the International Museum of the Reformation
- Free time in Geneva (options include visiting the Patek Phillipe Museum, CERN Science Gateway, Maison Tavel Museum of Art & History, or International Red Cross & Crescent Museum)



Sunday, September 26

- Morning Walking tour of Lausanne
- Rest of the day is free time (options include visiting the Olympic Museum, Montreux, Chillon Castle, Fortress Chillon, or Manoir de Ban Charlie Chaplin's house)



Monday, September 27

- Morning Train from Lausanne to Zweisimmen (Golden Pass)
- Van to Alpine farm tour and cheesemaking demonstration
- Afternoon train to Bern



Tuesday, September 28

- Morning walking tour of Bern
- Visit and tour of the Swiss Federal Palace
- Friends of the Swiss American Historical Society annual meeting and group lunch
- Rest of the day is free time (can explore the many museums in Bern or take the train to Interlaken)

Wednesday, September 29
