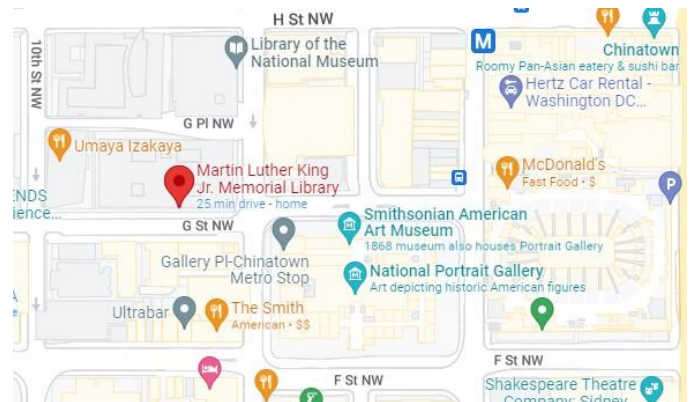

Annual North American Meeting

We are pleased to announce that after two years of not meeting due to the pandemic, we will have our 1st in person annual North American meeting on Saturday, October 8, 2022 in Washington, DC! Due to renovations continuing at the Embassy of Switzerland, we will meet instead at the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Library. The library is in the Gallery Place-Chinatown neighborhood within walking distance of hotels, restaurants, museums and a metro station. If you are coming by train from Union Station, you can take the Metro from Union Station in the direction of Shady Grove and get off at the Gallery Place-Chinatown station.

Off the Beaten Path things to do in Washington, DC

[Hillwood Museum, Estate & Gardens](#) is a decorative arts museum in Washington, D.C., United States. The former residence of businesswoman, socialite, philanthropist and collector Marjorie Merriweather Post, Hillwood is known for its large decorative arts collection that includes Fabergé eggs.

[The International Spy Museum](#) is a private museum which documents the tradecraft, history, and contemporary role of espionage. It holds the largest collection of international espionage artifacts on public display. The museum moved to a new location and brand new building in 2019 at L'Enfant Plaza.

[President Woodrow Wilson House](#) was the residence of the 28th President of the United States, Woodrow Wilson after he left office. It is at 2340 S Street NW just off Washington, DC's Embassy Row. On February 3, 1924, Wilson died in an upstairs bedroom. It was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1964.

[Embassy Row walking tours](#) introduces you to the many embassies and residences around Dupont Circle once known as “millionaires’ row.” You can do a self-guided free walking tour or book a guided tour from the link.
